

4) Mutual Help ~ Fellowship Groups provide meals to its members during times of convalescence, childbirth or other times of stress. They should likewise help one another with other physical needs, such as folks moving across town, or by taking care of their elderly members.

5) Outreach Teams ~ Each Fellowship Group should work together to help spread the Gospel in Statesboro. The Session has tasked each Group to undertake one outreach project per year.

6) Mercy Teams ~ Each Fellowship Group should work together to provide for the physical needs of people outside of our church. Again, the Session has tasked each Group to undertake one mercy project per year.

7) Discipleship ~ Each of the officers should get to know the people in their Fellowship Groups well enough to know their particular spiritual needs, and are there to help individuals and families work through their problems in a biblical manner. In order to better know the needs of the flock here at Trinity, the Session has set a goal to call each member or family of the Fellowship Groups once a month.

FAQ:

1) Do I have to be a member of TPC to be in a Fellowship Group?

No. It is our hope that every regular attender will join TPC to be under the authority of Christ in His church, but we realize that this takes time. In the meantime, we hope that you avail yourself of a Fellowship Group.

2) How do I join a Fellowship Group?

Usually you will be invited to participate in one by someone in the church you have gotten to know. After attending TPC for some time, or after joining, we will assign you to one of the Fellowship Groups.

3) Why aren't our Fellowship Groups organized by age and life status?

The Session believes that at this time, it is best to mix it up with one another across ages and situations so that we are all able to enjoy the full breadth and diversity of God's people.

4) Can I change which Fellowship Group I am in?

We like people to try to stay in the group they are in, but if you feel strongly about the need to change, let one of the pastors know, and we will bring it up with the Session and try to accommodate your request.

Fellowship Groups at Trinity Presbyterian Church

In order to provide for better community, outreach and pastoral care, the Session has organized our church into four Fellowship Groups. Each Fellowship Group meets at least once a month, usually after the 11 AM worship service for a meal together in Westminster Fellowship Hall. Every member and regular attender is assigned to a Fellowship Group. This is in addition to any other Bible studies or prayer groups which they may attend. It is our belief that this will help us imitate the life of the early church described in Acts 2:42: *And they were continually devoting themselves to the apostles = teaching and to fellowship, and to the breaking of bread and to prayer.*

The Purpose and Function of Fellowship Groups at TPC

1) Community ~ Fellowship Groups are a way for us to get to know one another and share in each other's lives on a regular basis.

2) Focused Prayer ~ Fellowship Groups are where we can ask for and find prayer for our particular needs. In addition, it serves as a useful phone chain for urgent prayer requests across the church.

3) Hails & Farewells ~ Fellowship Groups are the place in our church where we can welcome new folks in and say good-bye to members who must sadly move away. They are also a good place to celebrate baptisms and children admitted to the Lord's Supper.
